

INSTALLATION, CARE AND WARRANTY

Thank you for the purchase of EnergySavr Window Inserts.

All window inserts are labeled by a number on the back of one of the corners which should match the invoice you received via email or included in the package. For installation, hold onto the panel using the frame and simply push the EnergySavr Window Inserts into the window frame opening at the place measured or specified by the person who measured. The vinyl film side goes on the back towards the glass. It is usually easiest to start by inserting the top then work the sides and bottom into place. 1-3 inches of space is recommended between the glass and insert if possible. The weather stripping should hold the insert in its proper place. Additional clips, weatherstripping or fasterners may be needed to hold inserts in place if too much air leaks in through window sashes or seals.

When removing the EnergySavr Window Insert, pull gently from the bottom or top corners by grabbing onto the frame. Once started work the other sides out. Storage of inserts upright on their sides is preferred instead of flat. Many customers store them behind a couch or headboard, in a closet or basement room or in the garage covered by a sheet. Cardboard can also be used to protect the inserts.

When cleaning the EnergySavr Window Inserts, use warm water (a little soap may be used but is seldom necessary) with a 100% cotton cloth (eg clean 100% cotton t-shirt). EnergySavr carries cans of vinyl cleaner which may also be used. Using anything other than a 100% cotton cloth may scratch the polyvinyl material.

Limited Warranty: EnergySavr will replace, repair, or send materials to repair product during the first 24 months due to defective materials only. Abuse, neglect or damage to vinyl, weatherstripping or frame is not covered. Customer may be responsible for shipping and handling charges.
